FRONT CONTROL ARM OUTER BUSH

Product description:

PFF57-802

PFF57-802 ALLOWS ON CAR ADJUSTMENT OF THE CASTER ANGLE.

Contents (parts per pack):

- 4 x bushes (2 x A part & 2 x B part)
- 2 x aluminium adjustable sleeves
- 1 x C spanner
- 1 x grease

Please read the complete fitting instructions and check package components before fitment. These fitting instructions are to be used as a guide and in conjunction with workshop manual. It is recommended that:

- all work to be carried out by a licensed technician;
- all safety precautions adhered to;
- wheel alignment to be checked and adjusted as required after any suspension work.

All fasteners must be tensioned to manufacturer's torque settings.

Fitting Instructions:

- 1. Remove the front control arm, remove the outer bush front the arm, clean the arm of any dirt and corrosion.
- 2. Fit 1 A & 1 B part bush into the arm, lubricate the bore and end faces of the bushes with some of the supplied grease.
- 3. Fit the sleeve into the bush, the end with the adjustment wheel fits against the A bush with the thinner top section.
- 4. Use the central hole if standard caster is required, use the offset hole if PFF57-801 has been fitted to the car or if caster adjustment is required.
- 5. Refit the arm to the car, carry out alignment check. If the caster requires adjustment slacken the bolt, adjust the caster to the desired setting with the C spanner, re tighten the bolt and recheck alignment.
